* This lecture will present ongoing research that is part of a project Causes of Peace – The Botswana, Zambia and Malawi »Zone of Peace« (funded by the Swedish Research Council). Botswana, Malawi and Zambia constitute a »Zone of Peace« spared from violent conflicts since independence. The project aims to explain why peace has prevailed in these countries, despite being located in the world's most volatile continent and with all their neighbours struck by conflict. The lecture will focus on describing Botswana's peace as well as seeking the causes to why Botswana has been spared from armed conflict.
